



2017-2018 TRI-M POINTS AND REQUIREMENTS

- Students are expected to attend each meeting (no more than once monthly)
- Students are expected to acquire 10 service points and 10 performance points each school year.
- Students are expected to pay the \$15.00 yearly due by December 1st.
- Students must be enrolled in a music class for at least one semester of the school year.
- Students must earn an A average in their music class(es) on the semester report card.
- Students must earn a cumulative B average in their non-music classes on the semester report card.

OPPORTUNITIES TO EARN PERFORMANCE POINTS

- **Solo** or **Ensemble** performance in church or community (2 points each)
 - o Performances that are graded or that you receive compensation for will not earn points.
- Attendance at performances that **do not** have admission fee. Please bring in a program the following day. (2 Points each)
- Attendance at performances that charge admission. Please bring a program the following day. (3 Points each)

OPPORTUNITIES TO EARN SERVICE POINTS

- Assisting with concert setup or break down (2 points each)
- Assisting with a music program at a middle or elementary school (2 points each)
- Participating in a Tri-M community service project sponsored by SHS (2 points each)
- Participating in any other community service effort deemed appropriate by Mr. Duncan (2 points each)
